

Sparkling Wines & Champagnes

27. Prosecco Lunetta – Italy - £22.00

Fresh and fruity with a soft, creamy mousse, a very easy drinking glass of Italy's favourite fizz.

28. Gremillet Brut Selection, Champagne - £38.50

This champagne shows fine mousse in the glass and fresh floral aromas mixed with characteristic sweet, doughy overtones, which are balanced by richer fruit, peach skin characters and classic baked biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish.

29. Gremillet Rose Brut, Champagne – 45.75

Attractive pinky colour, and it's good fruity stuff with ripe strawberry and vanilla rolling over your tongue. That's enhanced by classic baked biscuit flavours and crisp yeastiness

30. Veuve Clicquot NV Brut – Champagne - £58.25

A prestigious 'House' making wonderful Champagne.

31. Laurent Perrier NV Rosé - Champagne - £89.00

An attractive and delicate pink Champagne, with a lovely pale salmon colour and delightful creamy strawberry and raspberry fruits.

32. Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut NV – Champagne - £60.00

Lovely classy, intense nose shows savoury bready notes and a touch of lifted acidity, with a complex toasty edge.

33. Dom Perignon Vintage Brut – Champagne - £159.75

Regarded as the pinnacle of excellence. An intensely flavoured Champagne, displaying tropical fruit, berry and citrus flavours and aromas, ending with an aftertaste of dried fruit.

34. Krug Grande Cuvée – Champagne - £167.50

Krug Grande Cuvée is the timelessly stylish signature of Krug, a breath-taking Champagne that effortlessly balances richness and freshness, power and finesse.

Dessert Wines

35. Araldica Moscato Passito – Piedmont, Italy - 37.5cl bottle - £16.75

Intense and delicious with a fresh tangy orange sweetness; what puddings are made for!

36. Paul Cluver Weisser Riesling Noble Late Harvest – South Africa - 37.5cl bottle - £28.00

Fabulous botrytis-affected Riesling bursting with juicy sweet apricot flavours with a faint hint of orange marmalade on the finish.

Port

37. Taylor's LBV - 50ml Glass £2.20

Concentrated fruity flavour and firm, full-bodied style make Taylor's LBV the perfect port to accompany chocolate desserts and blue cheeses.

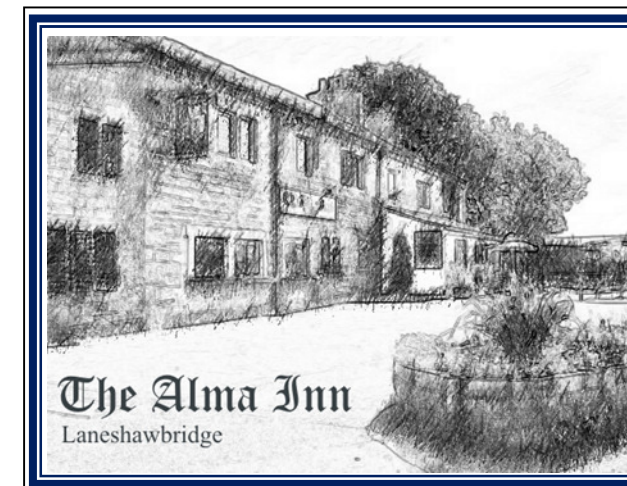
38. Taylor's 10 Year Tawny - 50ml Glass £2.70

An exceptionally fine old tawny blend, aged for an average of 10 years in oak casks. Elegant and smooth, combining delicate wood notes and rich mellow fruit, it is bottled for immediate drinking.

39. Krohn 1963 Cohletia - 50ml Glass £6.35

Why not treat yourself to a glass of this exceptional, gold-medal-winning vintage Tawny Port. Complex Xmas-cake flavours, staggering length and balance.

White Wines

1. Paarl Heights Chenin Blanc – Franschhoek, South Africa - £15.75

Deliciously fresh, aromatic, off-dry white with ripe peachy summer fruit flavours and a soft, round, long finish.

2. Pinot Grigio Ancora – Lombardy, Italy - £17.50

Italy's most fashionable white ... A nicely rounded easy-drinking style, softly perfumed yet with delicate, fresh, citrus fruit flavours.

3. Moko Black Sauvignon Blanc, Central Otago - £24.95

Zesty citrus with white stone fruits. Hints of gooseberry rolling into a full layered palate finishing with a lovely balance of texture, weight and clean refreshing finish.

4. Domaine de la Motte, Chablis Vieilles Vignes – Burgundy, France - £34.75

One of the best known villages of northern Burgundy, Chablis is made from 100% Chardonnay grapes. The Chablis Vieilles Vignes from le Domaine de la Motte is produced with 40 year-old vines. The lower yields allow the aromas to be fuller and the roundness in the mouth -exceptional.

5. The Last Stand Chardonnay – Victoria, Australia - £18.25

Soft, lingering and full of tropical and citrus fruit flavours, balanced by fresh acidity with subtle hints of creamy vanilla oak.

6. Tierra Alta Sauvignon Blanc – Central Valley, Chile - £15.50

Crisp, fresh and fruity this is a classic Sauvignon Blanc; with attractive herbaceous qualities that make it great on its own or with food.

7. Willowglen Semillon Chardonnay – South Eastern Australia - £16.25

Gold-medal-winner that's on the list at Buckingham Palace! Creamy, tropical fruits combined with crisp, citrus flavours.

8. Pouilly-Fumé Dom de Maltaverne – Loire, France - £32.75

Classic Sauvignon Blanc, lean racy and concentrated with complex citrus and mineral flavours.

9. Bodegas Borsao Macabeo - Campo de Borja – Spain - £16.25

Aromatic, with delicate apple and pear fruit on the nose. Made from 100% Macabeo grapes, this wine is floral and fresh, with crisp acidity and a long pure fruit finish.

10. Gavi Bracco Batistina – Piedmont, Italy - £22.75

Aromatic, juicy, nose full of lime with some sappy pear skin notes. Richly textured palate with a well integrated backbone of spice from the oak and a delicately perfumed peach blossom finish.

11. Vallet Frères Auxey Duresses – Burgundy, France - £62.25

One of Burgundy's top producers, Bernard Vallet creates a wine of exquisite complex butterscotch and citrus aromas that are matched by full tropical fruits on the palate and beautifully balanced acidity.

12. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand - £49.25

World famous Sauvignon Blanc that is bursting with passion fruit, gooseberry and elderflower tones, its zesty palate is mouth-wateringly refreshing.

Red Wines

13. Borsao Grenache – Campo de Borja, Spain - £16.25

Soft, fruity, attractive lively red, which is unhindered by oak ageing, something of a rarity in Spain!

14. Coto de Imaz Reserva – Rioja, Spain - £34.75

Intense black-cherry colour with an attractive, powerful berry-fruit nose with hints of vanilla and spice. Velvety soft on the palate, this is a wine with grace and character.

15. Tierra Alta Merlot – Central Valley, Chile - £16.00

Uncomplicated and easy-drinking.....Silky smooth and packed full of soft, juicy plum and blackcurrant fruit flavours, with a warm peppery finish.

16. Guardian Peak Shiraz – Western Cape, South Africa - £23.75

Mix of dark chocolate, cherries, plums and stewed fruit. Excellent follow through of cherry flavours on the palate.

17. Three Monks Cabernet Merlot – Australia - £24.00

The classic Bordeaux blend - Australian style. Rich plum and cassis fruit overlay a firm structure with great balance. A beautifully crafted wine.

18. Villa la Pagliaia Chianti Classico – Tuscany, Italy - £25.75

Lovely perfumed blueberry and cherry fruit, interwoven with rich spices and liquorice. A tightly knit palate with supple tannins and a pleasant savoury character integrated into the fruit and spice.

19. Pierre Bourée , Côte de Beaune Villages, Burgundy, France - £41.55

A fine Burgundy produced by traditional methods - authenticity is key to the quality here.

20. Trivento Tribu Pinot Noir – Mendoza, Argentina - £16.25

Great value Pinot from an unlikely source, packed with fresh strawberry and mushroom characters.

21. Hawke's Bay, Merlot, New Zealand - £27.75

Rich black fruit flavours of plum, berry & currants are to the fore underpinned with savoury oak. Fine tannins and lovely balance promote a fleshy texture and lingering finish.

22. Keith Tulloch Per Diem, Cabernet Sauvignon, South Australia - £26.80

This medium bodied red wine is soft yet bursting with vibrant ripe black plum and cherry sweetness and a complex savoury velvet mouth feel. The tannins are soft and there is some lively acid on the finish, keeping the wine fresh and focused.

23. Villa Martis, Marques de Gresi – Piedmont, Italy - £45.50

A complex and elegant blend of Nebbiolo and Barbera grapes from one of Northern Italy's greatest vineyards.

24. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Domaine Chante Cigale – Rhone, France - £51.50

This complex wine has warm red spicy fruit and damson aromas, dense dark cherry fruit on the palate; structure, richness and a touch of elegance at the finish.

Rosé Wines

25. Discovery Beach, Zinfandel Rose, California - £16.25

Ripe watermelon, strawberries & cherry balanced with a floral character, sweetness & crisp acidity to create a Zinfandel Rose every palate can enjoy.

26. El Coto Rosado – Rioja, Spain - £18.25

This lovely rose is fresh and dry with fruity aromas of strawberry, raspberry and grapefruit.
